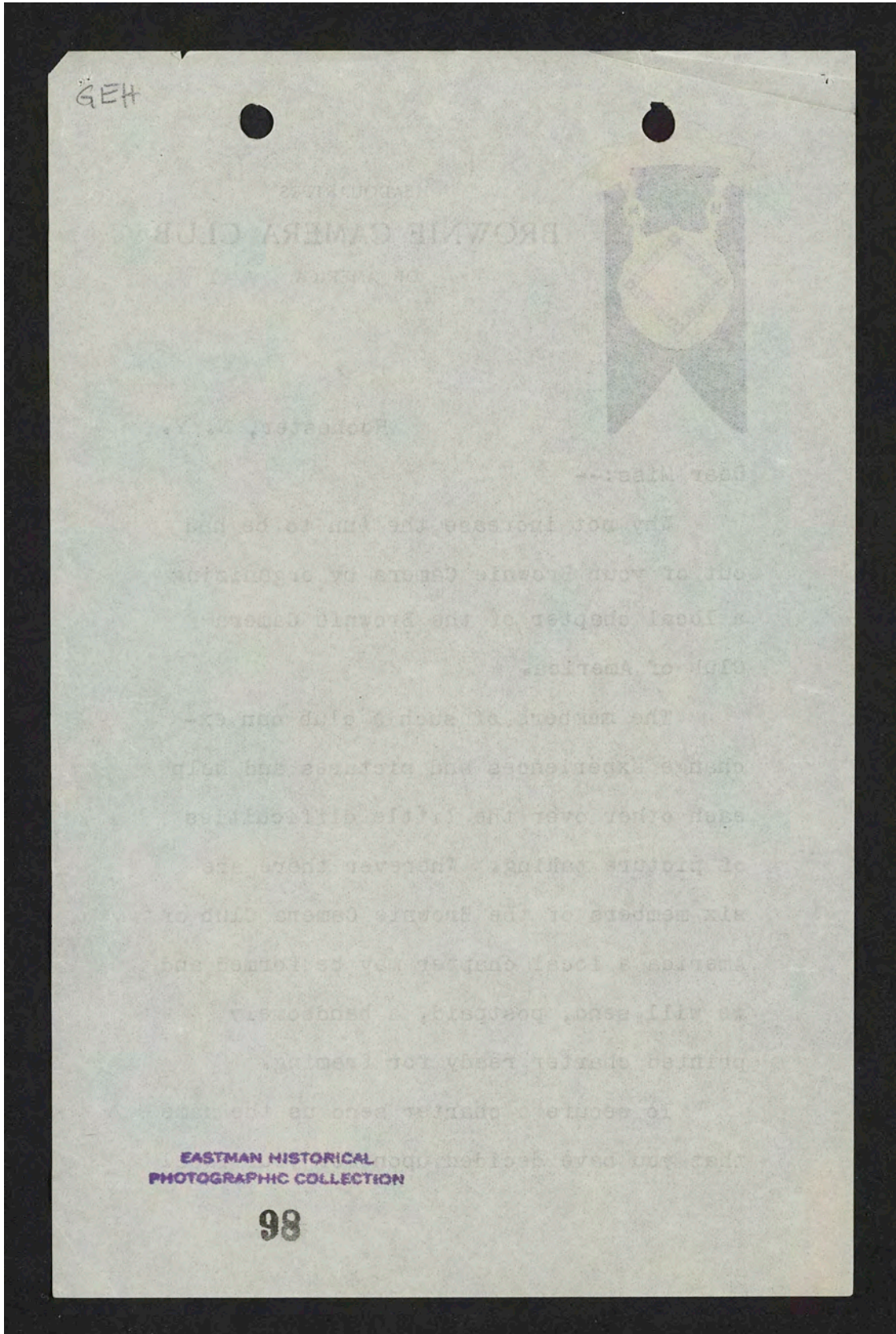
Dear Miss:--

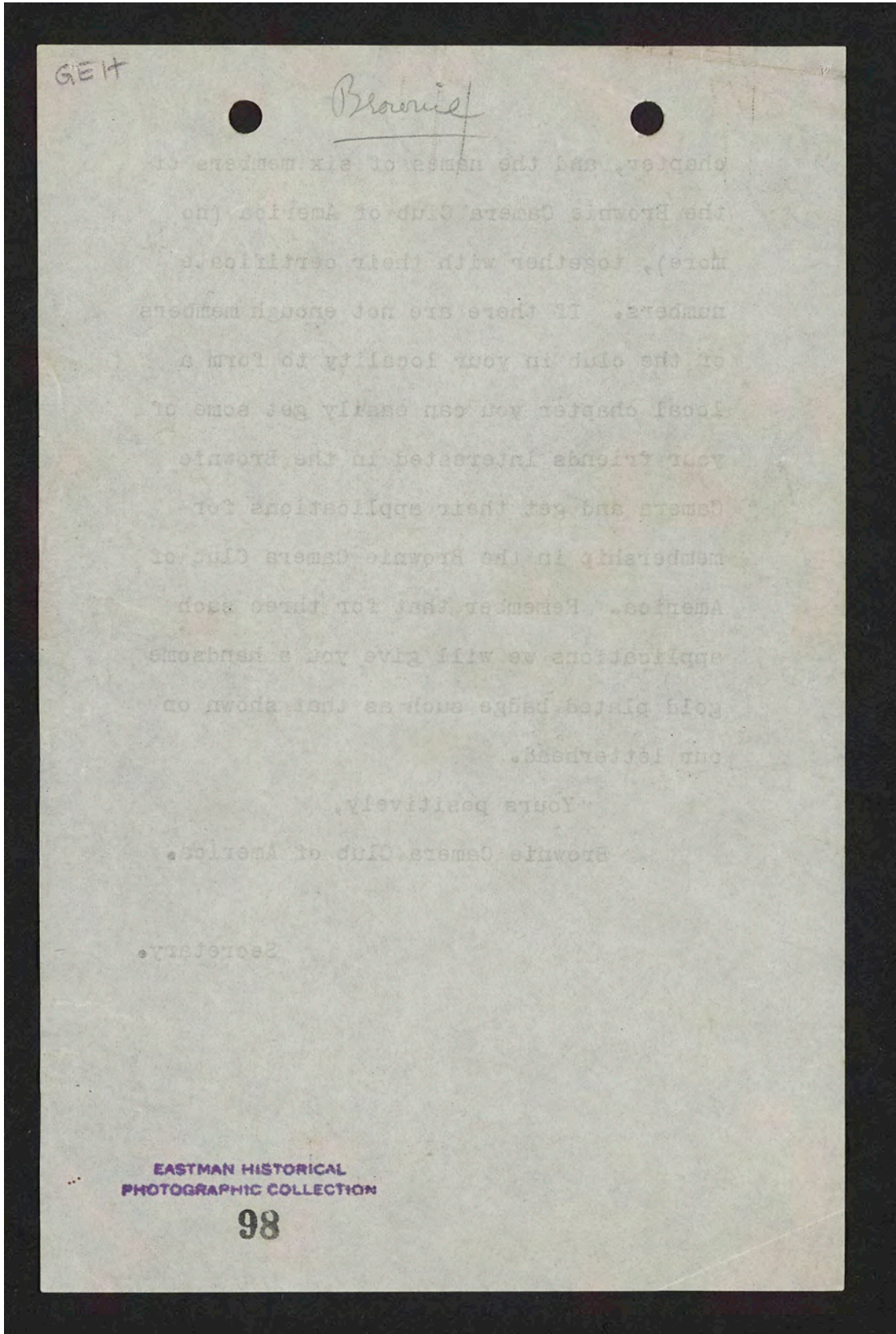
