"When you ask what have we accomplished, really accomplished, it isn't really that much. It's a very frustrating place... During the campaign, the goal is very clear. Here the goal is a fuzzy mixture of politics, partisanship and doing the right thing. We are trying to push back the reelection thing once in a while to do the right thing. When we came here, I thought the six year term would insulate up enough so that we could do the right thing. But I've found out that isn't the case." Idea is they have to work at it."

He said he'd spent the last 3 months getting DOD to change the way they evaluate PA coal for military bases. And that they had agreed to a change yesterday. It means 75,000 more tons of anthracite.

He's now working on bill to deny pensions to convicted congressmen and he's lobbying OSHA to inspect places where carcinogens are dangerous-nickel,
