- Talk with Rebecca Kirsner, Fattah's press secretary--Clark University grad--intern/staff. She said this twice, with exclamation in point.
- "The press release had already been written," for his appointment to Appropriations.
- "Up to now, it's been Appropriations, Appropriations, Appropriations. Now he's saying, 'I could become Chairman of the Education Committee,' But his heart isn't in it. He's in a funk."
- "The whole office is in a funk. It's been a down period in the office." Appropriations plus impeachment. "Everyone agreed that the Democrats owed the CBC because of the turnout in the election. They had four slots. One was promised to the Congressman."
- "He's paid his dues to the Democratic party. But I guess he hadn't paid his dues to the CBC. I think Clyburn got his seat. He wasn't even in it at the beginning. But he is head of the CBC. It was about all cutting deals."
